Achieving a step change in speed

Overview

In December 2017 the Associate Minister of Transport, Hon Julie Anne Genter, challenged road controlling authorities to consider ways they could accelerate the implementation of the new approach to speed management. In February she invited local government to a road safety Summit on 9 April. This Trafinz workshop will provide an update on the work NZ Transport Agency have been doing to respond to the Minister's challenge, and an overview from the three regions (Waikato, Auckland and Canterbury) that are planning a step change in the way they implement speed management. The workshop will conclude with a discussion on accelerating speed management across the rest of the country, and inform the local government contribution to the April road safety Summit.
